- The panels are cut from automotive panel board, covered, and ready for installation
- Extra material is supplied for covering the steel window trim parts
- The Headliner is sewn and ready to install along with the small cording trim
- Windlace trim is made for around the door openings
- Carpet kick panels (when required)
- Lower part of door panels have carpet (when required)
- Carpet trim for the backside of front driver's seat (1926-27 Tudor) and seat frame (1923-27 Fordor)
- Hardware package includes: tacks, wire brads, brad needle, hog rings and pliers, sewing thread, carpet fasteners (if ordered), and instructions
- Interior Kits are complete and finished up to the point of installation (Floor carpet is sold separately)

1919-22 Upholstery Material

Brown hairline stripe cloth is used on the seats, door panels, and lower side panels. Plain cloth is used on the upper panels and windlace. Grey was also an option for 1919.

1923-25 Upholstery Material

Brown stripe cloth is used on the seats, door, and lower side panels. Plain brown cloth is used on all upper panels and the headliner. Black leatherette material is used for windlace.

1926-27 Coupe and Tudor Upholstery Material

Grey with green strip is used on the seats, door panels, and lower side panels. Plain gray cloth is used on all upper panels and the headliner. Black leatherette material is used for windlace.

1926-27 Fordor Upholstery Material

Grey with red stripe is used on the seats, door panels, and lower side panels. Plain gray cloth is used on all upper panels and the headliner. Black leatherette material is used for windlace.

All Model T closed cars were originally equipped with floor carpet. Rubber mats became available, but were not original equipment from Ford. Our wool carpet sets are bias bound on all sides, including the cut out for the pedals. The correct rubber heel pad is sewn to the driver's side of the mat. Our carpet sets **include fasteners and seat risers.**

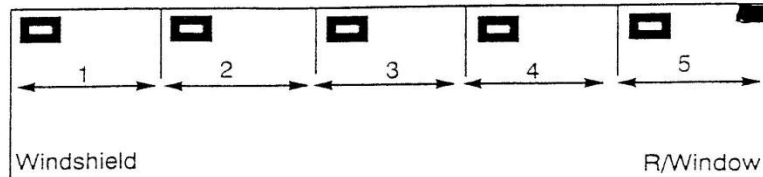
Sun Visor Covering Kits

Sun visor covers are sewn to detail and include: screws, washers, and are ready to install. **23-25 Please advise to length of steel frame and if you have original or reproduction parts**

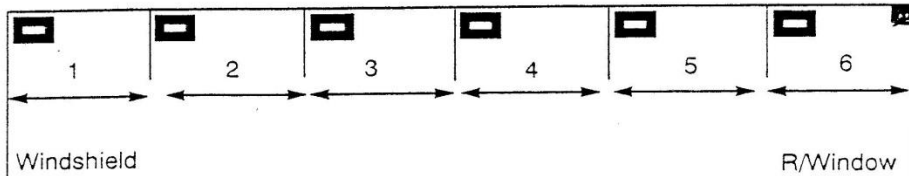
